THE HOLY SPIRIT

THE HOLY SPIRIT AND THE NEWLY BORN IN CHRIST (NEW CHRISTIAN)

WHEN YOU BECOME BORN AGAIN:

- a. Your human spirit is the part of your being which becomes born again, meaning your spirit becomes ALIVE towards God Almighty. (Romans 8:15-16 ; Galatians 4:6; 2Corinthians 1:22 [earnest of the Spirit])
- b. The Holy Spirit comes to in- dwell you immediately. (John 20:19-22; John 14:17; Ephesians 1: 13; 1 Corinthians 6:17; 1 Corinthians 12:3b)
- c. The first sign of the Holy Spirit's presence in your heart:
 - You experience **the Love of God** and **the Joy of the Lord** (Romans 5:5; John 15:11)
 - Fear goes away (Romans 8:15; 2 Timothy 1:7)
 - There is an assurance of the love, acceptance, and the abiding presence of Father and the Son in your life (John14:23)
- d. The Holy Spirit is also a promise from the father to you, the born-again Christian.

WHY IS THIS SO?

Anyone born from the line of Adam after he fell into sin, is born in the sinful nature of Adam, which is a life that is dead towards God and without the Holy Spirit (Genesis 5:3).

Unfortunately, every human being without Jesus Christ falls into this category because the sin of Adam was passed on to all mankind (Romans 3:23; Genesis 6:3).

When you are born without the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, you are said to be dead towards God (both Spiritually and in the natural) and excluded from the family line of God- that is, you are none of His (Romans 8:9b).

Jesus is the only exception to this because His conception, birth, growth into maturity, ministry, death, resurrection, and His ascension into heaven all involve the Holy Spirit.

God used the life of Jesus to demonstrate the vital importance of the Holy Spirit in the life of a person.

Note: From the beginning, God Almighty's intension for Adam was not for him to sin and carry every human being into sin and a life without the Holy Spirit.

Because that was not God's plan from the beginning, He had to **do something** about it.

He displayed every stage in the life of Jesus to show His original plan of how the life of every human being should be, before the fall of Adam.

What Then Was God's Original Plan?

The desire of God Almighty from the beginning is that every human being should be filled with (conceived and born full of) His Spirit, the Holy Spirit (Joel 2:28).

This desire of God is shown in His creation of man:

- The creation of Adam was all planned, master minded, and displayed by the Holy Spirit without any human involvement.
- Adam became alive towards God, born in the image of God when God Almighty filled him with the Holy Spirit (the breath of God, the Spirit of God) (Genesis 2:7).

When Adam fell into sin, he lost everything and became empty of the Holy Spirit

Without the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, no one can work the works of God, nor portray the image of God.

GOD'S INTERVENTION

Because God Almighty did not intend for all mankind to bear the sins of Adam, He had to do something about it.

He therefore gave us Jesus, to be the sacrificial lamb, the one who should pay for the sins of Adam by dying in place of every human being. Jesus died on the cross so that

anyone who receives Him and His atoning sacrifice, can receive the Spirit of God into his or her life (John 3:16; John 7:37-39a).

Accepting Jesus is the key to the infilling of the Holy Spirit. It gives you the opportunity to be born all over again in Jesus, so that you can have the Holy Spirit come into your life.

This whole process is done by the Spirit of God Himself, and is similar to Jesus being born again when he rose from the dead.

When you receive Jesus Christ as your savior, God promises you a fresh infilling of the Holy Spirit, free of charge.

The Holy Spirit is a promise made by God the Father, to you and whosoever believes in Jesus Christ (Isaiah 59:21; Ezekiel 36:26-27; Joel 2:28-29; Isaiah 28:11; Luke 11:13; Acts 1:4-5).

WHO WILL SEND THE HOLY SPIRIT (THE PROMISE) TO YOU WHEN YOU RECEIVE JESUS AS YOUR SAVIOR?

The Holy Spirit is sent to you by **JESUS** (John 14:15-19,26; 15:26; 16:7,15; Luke 24:49).

WHY IS JESUS THE SENDER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT WHEN GOD THE FATHER IS THE ONE WHO MADE THE PROMISE?

According to the law given to Moses by God Almighty in Deuteronomy 21:17, the firstborn son holds the birthright to the double portion of all the father's possessions after the death of the father.

Is Jesus The Firstborn Son of God to Own All That The Father Has?

- a. Yes. Scripture Shows That JESUS IS THE FIRSTBORN SON OF GOD.
 - Jesus is the **Seed of Abraham** (this term is used to describe Jesus as the **firstborn** of Abraham; Galatians 3:6)
 - He is also referred to as the **Son of David** (a term used to describe Him as the **firstborn** of David to inherit the throne of King David; Luke 1:32-33)
 - Jesus is the **firstborn** son of Joseph and Mary (Luke 2:7)
 - He is the **firstborn of every creature** spiritually in God (Colossians 1:15).
 - He is the **firstborn among many brethren**. Brethren here is referring to those who saved, born again, and are in Christ Jesus (Romans 8:29).
 - Jesus is the **first begotten of God** (Hebrews 1:6).
 - He is the **firstborn of God from the dead** (Colossians 1:18).
 - Jesus is the **firstborn** (first begotten) **Son of God** (Psalms 2:7; Hebrews 1:5-10)

- b. Apart from being the firstborn Son of God which qualifies Him as the owner of all that God has, Jesus also ACCOMPLISHED CERTAIN TASKS given to Him by His Father. The father therefore rewarded Him for those accomplishments which were:
1. Jesus defeated sin for all mankind
 2. He conquered death, hell, and the grave.

After receiving the double portion of the blessing, Jesus purposefully prayed to the father that He will share this blessing (the Glory He received from the Father) with anyone who believes in Him and becomes saved (John 17:22,24).

Jesus also **owns the church** because He is the **firstborn Son of God** (Hebrews 12:23).

That is why the bible says that Jesus was fully aware that the father has put all things into His hands. He also lets us know that all that the father has are His (John 13:3; John 16:15).

A Closer Look At How Jesus Became The Firstborn Son Of God

Jesus is the first and only man who died (John 19:30-33), and went to hell (Psalms 16:10a; Matthew 27:50-52; Acts 2:27).

He is also the first and the only man to rise from the death, hell and the grave without his body decomposing, and is spiritually alive towards God (Psalms 16:10-11 ; John 20:10-17; Matt. 28:5-6)

Jesus became born again to God Almighty when He rose from the dead and the grave (Psalms 2:7).

God declares through the prophesy of Isaiah that Jesus Is His SON whose NAME shall be called The Mighty God and The Everlasting Father (Isaiah 9:6)

The message from God Almighty through the angel Gabriel to Mary, the fulfillment of the prophesy from the book of Isaiah above, is:

- Mary shall conceive by the Holy Ghost and give birth to a Son
- His Name shall be called Jesus, and The SON of God (Luke 1:31-32,35)

You may say, “some other men rose from the dead, while others were also taken to heaven just like Jesus, so what is the big deal?”

Let's take a look at those people: -

- **ENOCH** was taken up to heaven by God, but he never tasted death, the grave, the wrath of God and hell like Jesus did (Genesis 5:21-24).
- **ELIJAH** was also taken up to heaven to be with God by a whirlwind, but like Enoch, he also never tasted death, the wrath of God, the grave or hell (2 Kings 2:3-12).

- **The daughter of Jairus**, a ruler of a Jewish synagogue, was brought back to life by JESUS, when she was not buried yet. She never tasted the grave, the wrath of God, or hell (Luke 8:40-56)
- Jesus called **LAZARUS** back to life after he was buried in a cave for some time, and his body was decomposing, but he never went through the judgement or the wrath of God.
- The son of the woman of Nain died and was brought back to life by Jesus, but he also never tasted the grave, hell, and the judgement of God (Luke 7:11-15).

Of all the men who were taken up to heaven or were called back to life from the dead, none of them:

- ❖ Was ever tempted by the devil and came out without sin
- ❖ Was rejected by God, went to hell, and suffered for the sins of all mankind
- ❖ Overcame sin, satan, hell and the lake of fire on behalf of all mankind.

To make a long story short, *JESUS IS THE FIRST MAN TO EVER DIE FOR THE SINS OF ALL MANKIND AND RISE FROM THE DEAD AS A RIGHTEOUS MAN (1 John 2:2, ; 2 Corinthians 5:15), BE REJECTED BY GOD BECAUSE OF OUR SINS (Psalms 22:2, ; Matthew 27:45-50), TAKE AWAY OUR SINS ON HIS CROSS (Colossians 2:14), AND DEFEAT SATAN AND DEATH (Colossians 2:15 ; Hebrews 2:14-15).*

After defeating satan and hell, God raised Him up from the dead, making Jesus the first begotten Son of God and the firstborn from the dead (Psalms 2:7; Hebrews 5:5; Acts 13:33; Colossians 1:18)

When Jesus rose from the dead as the firstborn Son of God, He fulfilled the scripture in Deuteronomy 21:17, both spiritually and naturally.

The position of firstborn Son qualified Jesus to fully inherit everything God Almighty owned (Hebrews 1:8-10).

God Almighty gave Jesus all authority and power in heaven and on earth (by giving Him a NAME that is above every name); all that He ever own, and the Holy Spirit (Matthew 28:18; Luke 24:49, Philippians 2:1-11)

The Father also loves Jesus because of what He accomplished (John 10:17-18), and has given all He owns into His hands (John 3:35).

Hence, Jesus can stand and say that all that the Father has are His (John 16:15)

God the Father and God the Holy Spirit are now working together to honor **the firstborn Son** by **MAKING HIS ENEMIES HIS FOOT STOOL** (Psalms 110:1-7; Matthew 22:44; Luke 20:41-43; Hebrews 1:8-14)

DUE TO THE LOVE JESUS HAS FOR US (John 13:1) AND THE COVENANT THAT HE MADE WITH US ON THE LAST SUPPER (Luke 22:17-20), HE CAN SHARE THE HOLY SPIRIT WITH ALL WHO RECEIVE HIM AND DECIDE TO LIVE IN HIS LOVE (John 17:22)

Remember, we said earlier that it has always been the Father's desire that all mankind be filled with the Holy Spirit (Joel 2:28-29). Because **Jesus Loves the Father**, He sent the Holy Spirit to us, to **fulfill the desires of the Father**.

3. **Intercessor** (Isaiah 59:16; Romans 8:26)
4. **Advocate** (John 14:26—comforter or advocate)
5. **Strengtheners** (Psalm 18:2; Isaiah 25:4, 26:4, 41:10; 2 Timothy 4:17)
6. **Standby** (Psalm 109: 30-31; 2 Timothy 4:17)

- ❖ The Holy Spirit is sent by Jesus to you, as your new **TEACHER** (John 14:26). He will always teach you about what Jesus has already done for you through His sufferings, death, resurrection and ascension (John 14: 26; 15: 26; 16: 13 -15; Ephesians 1: 16-23; 1 John 2: 27).
- ❖ The Holy Spirit **TESTIFIES** of your relationship with God the Father through Jesus Christ, the Son (Romans 8:16; 1 John 3:24).
- ❖ The Holy Spirit has become your **GUIDE**. As a Christian you will need a guide in all the things of God (John 16:13; Romans 8:14).
- ❖ If you rely on the HOLY SPIRIT, He will **HELP** you to live a life pleasing to GOD and for His Glory (Galatians 5: 16,17-25). He will help you to pray more and better (Romans 8:26; Ephesians 6:18).
- ❖ The Holy Spirit **HEALS** and **releases life** into our natural bodies (Romans 8:11).
- ❖ The Holy Spirit **REPROVES** (convicts) the world or the unsaved person of: -
 - SIN --- because they do not believe in Jesus Christ as the savior of the world from sin, death and eternal damnation (John 16:9).
 - RIGHTEOUSNESS--- because they have not accepted and chosen the sacrificial death of Jesus Christ as the only righteous way approved by God to come to Him and be accepted by Him (John 16: 10).
 - PENDING JUDGEMENT--- because they did not believe in the Father as the True Living God, and Jesus Christ as His only Son whom the Father sent as a sacrifice for their sins (John 16: 11; 17: 3; 1 John 5:10; Revelations 21: 8).

YOU MUST KNOW YOU ARE A SPIRIT BEING.

The Holy Spirit write's through the Apostle Paul, letting **you** know that you are a spirit being, that has a soul and lives in a human body (1Thessalonians 5:23; Hebrews 4:12).

Anyone born of God is also like God because the **seed** of God which is the very nature of God is in him (1 John 3:9; 1Peter 1:23-25). So, if God is Spirit (John 4:24a), then you, being made in His very likeness (Genesis 1:26), are also a living Spirit like Him.

When you give your life to Jesus: ...

1. The Holy Spirit comes in to **SEAL** (**envelop**) your born-again spirit, and keep you in God Almighty (Ephesians 1:13; 4:30).
2. Your **body** now becomes the **legal property** of the HOLY SPIRIT (1 Corinthians 6:20; 7:23), **and** the **dwelling place** (temple) of the Holy Spirit of God (1 Corinthians 3:16-17; 6:19). Therefore, keep your body holy for the Lord.
3. Your **soul** is redeemed, sanctified, and **set apart** from sin and destruction (1 Corinthians 6:11, Hebrews 2:11; 10:10,14).

You must know that YOUR SOUL IS IN THE PROCESS OF RESTORATION BY THE HOLY SPIRIT. It is very important for you to understand that restoration is a **process** and *not overnight*. So, you are going to encounter some mistakes and difficulties here and there, but do not give up. Confess your sins immediately when that happens, and receive your **forgiveness from the Lord** (1John 1:9). Do not let the devil bring guilt to cloud your mind and block your blessing because when God forgives your sin, He totally erases it from memory and does not accuse you (Hebrews 8:12). Make every conscious effort not to look back at the sin again by quickly focusing on the unfailing agape love of God for you. Remember, **IT IS GOD ALMIGHTY WHO IS DOING THE RESTORATION, AND NOT A MAN** (Psalm 23:3; James 1:21)

WHAT ELSE DOES THE HOLY SPIRIT DO IN THE LIFE OF A BELIEVER?

--- The Holy Spirit releases into you the supernatural power of God, and boldness comes into you to be a faithful witness of Jesus Christ (Acts 1:8; 2:14-40).

--- He is the only one that introduces you, the believer into the supernatural realm of God through the Name of Jesus (Acts 2:4; 10:46; 19:6; 1 Corinthians 12:4,8-10).

--- The Holy Spirit reveals Jesus Christ, and testifies to us that He is alive (Acts 4:31-33; 5:30-32).

--- He brings to the child of God, revelations to the scriptures and understanding (John 16:13; 1 Corinthians 2:9-10).

--- Your spirit is filled with true worship by the Holy Spirit (John 4:24; Ephesians 5:18-19).

--- The Holy Spirit always glorifies Jesus (John 16:13-15).

WHO CAN BE BAPTIZED IN THE HOLY SPIRIT?

Anyone who believes and accepts Jesus Christ as his/her Lord and savior, and is willing to obey God (... the Holy Ghost whom God has given to them that obey Him. Acts 5:32)

WHY DO WE NEED TO BE BAPTIZED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT?

God Almighty desires that the Holy Spirit will fill us *with power* to the overflow, so we can serve Him without fear (Ephesians 5:18; Luke 1:74)

HOW TO BE BAPTIZED IN THE HOLY GHOST.

- ❖ The Holy Spirit is a gift promised by God (**Luke 11:13**; Jeremiah 31:33; 32:39-40; Ezekiel 11:19; 36:27; 37:14; Joel 2:28-30; Hebrews 8:10-12).
Jesus told the disciples that He will send them the Holy Spirit, whom His Father promised (Luke 24:49)
- ❖ Ask the Father in Jesus name to baptize you with the Holy Ghost and power.
Remember, Jesus assured us that whatever we ask the father in His Name, He will give it to us (John 16:23; Mathew 7:7-11; 1 John 5:14-15; Romans 8:32).
- ❖ Ask the elders in church to join their faith with yours by laying their hands on you in prayer to receive the Holy Spirit and power of God (Acts 8:17; 19:6).
- ❖ Begin thanking God, **knowing that by faith** you have received **the gift of the Holy Ghost and the power of God** (Hebrews 6:13-18).
- ❖ God has released the supernatural language in your spirit, so **open your mouth now** and **begin to speak by faith** the Holy language of God, also known as other tongues. (Mark 16: 17; Acts 2:4; 10:45-46; 1 Corinthians 14:2).
